Entry Requirements

- i. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with at least Grade C (GP2.00) in any TWO (2) subjects; OR
- ii. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with at least grade Jayyid; OR
- iii. Matriculation or Foundation with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- iv. A Diploma (Level 4 Malaysian Qualifications Framework, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- v. An Advanced Diploma (Level 5, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- vi. A Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM) / Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) subjected to LUC Senate Approval*;
OR
- vii. A Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM) subjected to LUC Senate Approval*;
Note (vi) & (vii): The HEPs are to conduct screening and provide necessary guidance specific to the discipline of the programme; OR
- viii. Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognized by the Malaysian Government. AND
- ix. Pass an interview (online / virtual / conventional) OR submission of student's portfolio, to be determined by the LUC as required.
