INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Intake: Ongoing Entry Requirements:

- i) A Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) with minimum CGPA of 2.50 or equivalent, as accepted by the Lincoln University College Senate; OR
- ii) A Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) or equivalent not meeting CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in relevant field; OR
- iii) Other qualifications recognized by the Malaysian Government.

For non-Malaysian citizens, please refer to the Malaysian Qualification Agency's (MQA) List of Overseas Qualifications & its equivalency with Malaysian Education System to see if you qualify for this course.

English Requirements:

International students must have proof of good proficiency in verbal and written English. For example, International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0 or its equivalent.
