- A Bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 must undergo prerequisite courses; OR
- A Bachelor's degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment AND must undergo prerequisite courses; OR
- Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian government as equivalent to the above requirements.
